- Coordinates and collaborates with public, agency, other state agencies and federal agencies in surface water-related issues.
- Resolves problems, discrepancies and deficiencies on petitions, applications, maps and reports in accordance with Wyoming law, rules and regulations.
- Manages the Safety of Dams Program which regulates the safety and structural integrity of qualifying water storage facilities in the state.
