The Western States Water Council (WSWC) and California Department of Water Resources, in collaboration with the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) are convening a workshop on advancing sub-seasonal to seasonal precipitation forecasting in San Diego, California on June 7-9.
