The Western States Water Council and the California Department of Water Resources are cosponsoring a workshop on irrigation management information systems and networks, to be held at the Doubletree San Diego Downtown in San Diego, California on August 25-26, 2016. The hotel offers complimentary airport shuttle. The workshop will begin Thursday, August 25 at 1:00 pm (check in at 12:30 pm) and conclude Friday, August 26 around noon.

Agricultural and municipal weather station networks are used for providing irrigation scheduling information to growers and municipal landscape managers. Accurate estimates of reference evapotranspiration and crop-specific evapotranspiration allow growers and landscape managers to improve water use efficiency by precisely scheduling irrigation to provide only the amount of water needed. The WSWC will collect information from the workshop for use in preparing a report on the status of existing networks, challenges in maintaining data coverage, data gaps, and opportunities for strengthening collection of this important data.
