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



Accelerate Project Delivery

Accomplishments to Date:

- Project Delivery:
 - ✓ Execution of Authorized Projects by Non-Federal Sponsors: Issued WRDA18 Sec 1153 implementation guidance
- Risk Informed Decision Making and Delegations of Authority:
 - ✓ Modifications to completed CW projects (Section 408) permissions
 - ✓ MSCs/Districts empowered to make decisions on policy for Emergency Supplemental Projects
 - ✓ Planning: MSC approval of feasibility milestones; Single policy and legal review

Key Actions in Progress:

- Delegate Decision Making: Continuing to delegate decision making authority to the lowest possible level.
- Streamlining Acquisition: Continuing to implement additional acquisition changes to accelerate project delivery.
- Innovation / Streamlining Project
 Execution: Continuing to revise our business process to accelerate project execution and pursue innovative methods to design/construct projects.
- Update Policy & Guidance: Continuing to update policy & guidance
- Non-Federal Implementation of Projects: Working to address barriers to this implementation and pursue activities that support non-Federal entities.





Transform Project Financing and Budgeting

Accomplishments to Date:

- P3 Policy:
 - ✓ Guidance from ASA(CW) issued September 2018
 - ✓ Request for information Federal Register notice closed Apr 2019
 - √ 4 of 8 projects selected for further development
- CWIFP Loans:
 - ✓ MOU with EPA signed
 - ✓ Draft credit subsidy model completed
 - ✓ Development of program structure and rules
- Civil Works Budgeting:
 - ✓ Completed analysis on cost of inefficient funding streams
 - Developed draft metrics that increase leveraging of Federal funds and

accelerate completion of existing portfolio

Key Actions In Progress:

- ☐ P3 Call for Proposals:
 - □ 4 P3 proposals being further developed (6-24 mo. completion)
- ☐ CWIFP:
 - ☐ Finalize credit subsidy model

CORPS WATER INFRASTRUCTURE FINANCING PROGRAM (CWIFP)



Need for Infrastructure Investment

- Non-Federal investment need \$60B levees and \$60B dams
- Corps unconstructed portfolio of ~\$96B
- Constrained Federal funding ~\$5B budget to service \$250B in assets and new construction
- New tools needed to address challenges

CWIFP – Federal Loan Program

- Shared authority with EPA Water Infrastructure Financing and Innovation Act (WIFIA)
- Finalize program structure and issue rules Spring 2020
- Notice of Funding Availability: FY2020, subject to appropriations
- Non-Federally owned, operated and maintained projects:
 - Flood Risk
 - Ecosystem Restoration
 - Improve waterways and harbors
- EPA \$60M appropriations > \$6B in loans > \$12B infrastructure investment.




Fargo-Moorhead Flood Risk Management P3

- \$2.4B Federal project Split Delivery Corps and Non-Federal sponsors responsible for distinct reaches
- Non-Federal DBFOM contract, anticipated close 2020
- 3 shortlisted firms, resumed contract actions in 2019
- Corps lead on NEPA and advisory capacity for P3

P3 Projects selected for additional development

- Program Objective innovative approaches to reduce costs and expedite delivery
 - Soo Locks, MI
 - LA River Ecosystem Restoration, CA
 - Brazos Island Harbor Channel Improvement, TX
 - Sabine Pass to Galveston Bay Coastal Storm Risk Management, TX
- Request for Information ~January 2020 for additional proposals







Improve Permitting and Regulation Reform

Accomplishments to Date:

- ✓ Streamlined Section 408 Permission Requests (modifications to CW projects)
- ✓ Alignment of Section 404/10/103 and 408 Programs
- Lead District policy for projects that span multiple districts
- Improved Public Access to Tracking Systems
- ✓ Mitigation Regulatory Guidance Letters:
 - ✓ on removal of obsolete structures
 - on credit release schedules for mitigation banks and equivalency in service areas
- ✓ One Federal Decision Implementation Guidance
- ✓ Guidance for State Assumption under Section 404(g)
- ✓ Regulation Reform reviewed 53 regulations

Key Actions In Progress:

- Waters of the US
 - ✓ Step 1: Re-codify pre 2015 definition
 - ☐ Step 2: Promulgate revised definition
- ☐ **Mitigation**: Revise 2008 Mitigation Rule to streamline third party mitigation process and approvals
- Nationwide Permits: Streamline processes and pre-construction notification (PCN) requirements
- Improved Transparency and Consistency: Review all existing guidance and modify, replace or rescind as necessary
- □ Tracking Systems: Established public website to view the status of some permit applications. Improve availability of information on status of 408 reviews.
- □ Civil Works Projects: Eliminate duplicative reviews for authorized Civil Works projects undertaken by non-Federal interests
