



The Bureau of Reclamation's Transportation Program Wednesday, November 18, 2020, at 10:00AM MST

The Bureau of Reclamation's Transportation Program is a new and developing program. Reclamation started receiving funding from the Federal Highway Administration through the Federal Lands Transportation Program (FLTP) in 2016. FLTP funding has allowed Reclamation to improve Reclamation owned transportation assets that are open to the public. FLTP funding has also provided opportunities to enhance Reclamation's existing partnerships with state, local, and other Federal agencies. Over half of Reclamation's 2,800 miles of public roads and 300 public bridges are maintained by Federal and non-Federal partners. This creates unique opportunities where FLTP funding, partner funding, and Federal Lands Access Program (FLAP) funding can be leveraged to meet the needs of each agency while also improving public access to Federal land. The Transportation Program has also developed Reclamation wide geospatial inventories covering Reclamation owned bridges, roads, parking lots, and trails.
